

Message from Mr Hobbs

Good afternoon

A warm welcome back to all of our children after half term. It was great hearing about all of their adventures whilst teaching in Ladoca this week.

We have been reviewing our attendance this week and are so pleased with so many of our children having not had any time off. We realise that going into the winter months there is an increased likelihood that your child will become unwell so I wanted to remind you of the guidance from Public Health England and the DFE about school attendance. If your child has been sick or has a tummy bug then they should be off school for at least 48 hours since the last "incident". If your child has a temperature then it is best to keep them off until their temperature drops. If your children has a cough or a runny nose but are generally well in themselves then please try and encourage them to come to school so that they don't miss any learning.

Social media and online activity can be a minefield for parents as often the children learn about things before we do. We are very lucky that in school we have a filtering and monitoring system that informs us if the children are trying to access anything they shouldn't be or even typing something inappropriate. At home its not as easy. The NSPCC share lots of guidance on how you can be more aware of what your child is accessing and the best ways to understand and monitor their use. 
Do you have a child born between 1 September 2020 and 31 August 2021?
