Dear Parent/Guardian,

School PE kit has been somewhat of an issue recently with pupils either not wearing the correct attire or not having any PE kit at all. School policy states that the PE kit should be: Trainers or plimsolls, Black shorts or tracksuit bottoms and a red t shirt with school logo.

If your child does not bring their PE kit to school they will still have to take part in PE lessons unless a letter is provided signed by parent stating that they are unable to participate in PE. Failure to bring a PE kit three times will result in a letter being sent home and a significant loss in golden time.

Free School Meal Eligibility

Your child may be entitled to get free school meals if you, as parent/ guardian, receive any of the following:

- * Income Support
- * Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- * Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- * Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- * The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- * Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- * Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- * Universal Credit - if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get).

If you think you may be eligible for free school meals and are not currently receiving this, please contact Jane in the school office.

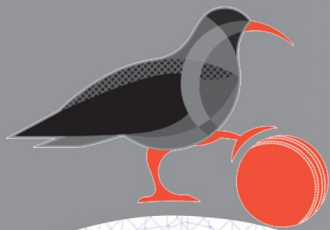
