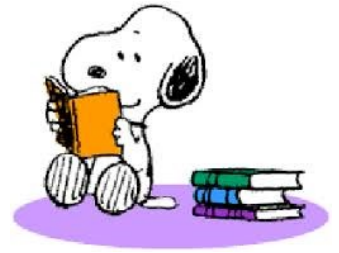

Create cute clay chicks with long wire legs and big plumes of feathers! Make them stand, sit or dance - decorate your Easter windowsill this holiday!

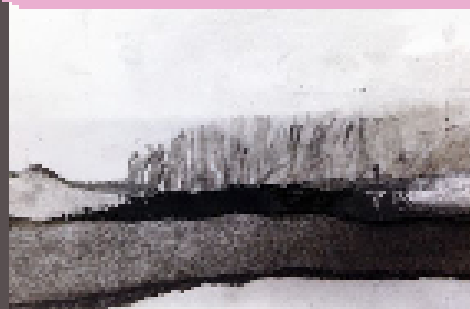


## COLLAGE LANDSCAPE MASTERCLASS

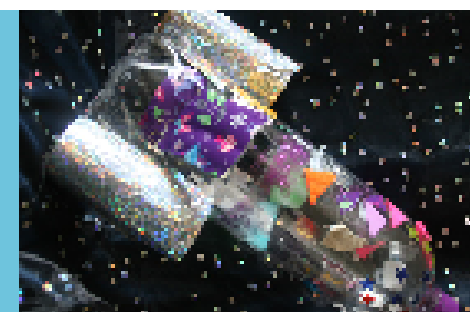

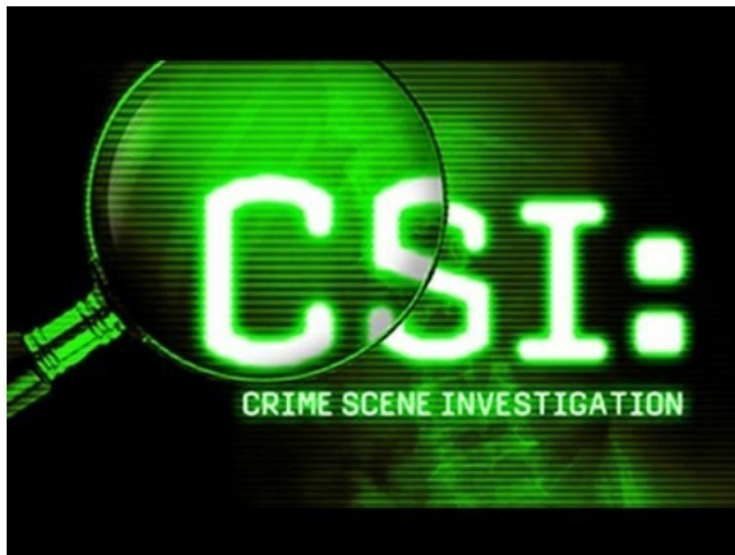
