

## Message from Mr Hobbs

Hi Everyone,

It's be fantastic to welcome everyone back with such fantastic weather. The children have really enjoyed being able to use all of our wonderful space during their break and lunchtimes. As the weather warms up please can we ask you to send your children to school with a water bottle so that they can keep hydrated throughout the day. We are unable to apply suncream to the children so please can you apply suncream before they come to school or teach them to apply it themselves. Please rest assured that we regularly remind the children about the importance or staying safe in the sun and we have plenty of areas within our outside space for them to find shade.

Earlier this week we had a visit from the RNLI lifeguards who spoke to the children from KS2 about staying safe near water and on our beaches. They were taught about the various flags and what to do if you get into trouble in the water. If you are taking a trip to the beach I can recommend the Mycoast App which gives up to date information on the conditions at many of our beaches but also whether the beach is patrolled by lifeguards. I'd also like to remind all of our families that last year we were donated a number of life jackets that we are able to loan out to families who are taking to the water and do not have access to them. Please get in contact if you need to borrow them.

Since returning from the Easter break all of our lunches have been delivered to the school by Chartwells and the response by the children has been incredibly positive. The lunches are cooked at Grampound Rd School and delivered to us at 12.30 in time for the children to eat immediately. The bookings go straight to Chartwells so it is important that they are made the night before and that desserts are booked for the children. Unfortunately, it is not always possible for us to make changes to the order on the day.


