Good afternoon,

I Think winter has definitely hit us this week. With the temperatures dropping and some of the surrounding area being affected by snow, it is worth reminding you all of our process should we need to shut the school. Any such decisions are always done with the safety of the parents, children and staff in mind and is not a decision that is taken lightly. The decision will be made based on the premises being safe and having enough staff to keep the children safe whilst they are here. Where possible I will opt for a late opening to allow everybody more time to travel in and to allow us to access the situation in daylight. Messages will be sent via Dojo and text and will be posted on the Council website and local radio stations. Many of our children travel in from neighbouring villages so even if we are open please only travel if it is safe to do so.
