## A note from Mr Stoyles

Welcome back to school and the start of the Summer term. I hope you had a great holiday and chance to enjoy the sunshine. As always, the school is a busy place! This week has already seen the children in Blaise class go on a trip to the Eden Project. Their impeccable behaviour during the trip was noticed by all members of staff at the school as well as members of the public visiting, especially as the rainforest biome was particularly warm on the day! As well as this, children in Keyne class had a visit from the Royal Cornwall Agricultural Trailer, something which they thoroughly enjoyed.

We are continuing to encourage fluidity between tasks set through mathematics at the school, believing that individual children flourish when introduced to new and existing concepts. This will informally assess their correct starting point in a session, meaning that they are constantly challenged and offered support where necessary.
