You will be presented with a log-in screen where you will need to enter your name, your email address (if you enter your email address, you will receive an email confirmation of your booking) and your child's name and DOB. You can then log on and continue with your booking(s). You can choose your child's class/teacher, and either day 1, 2 or 3. It is very straight forward, but if you do have a problem, or do not have access to the internet, please speak to Jane, who can make the booking(s) for you.

Annual nasal flu vaccinations—10th October 2018

Reception, Years 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5

In 2018/19 all children in Reception and school years 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5 will be offered the vaccine.

Ladock School is due for their vaccinations on the 10th October during the afternoon.

This year, Kernow Health are introducing a digital consent, otherwise known as e-consent, which will take away a significant part of the administration and paper-trails. In summary e-consent will mean:

- No paper (unless you would prefer paper)
- A simple email letter to you with instructions.
- No consent forms coming back to school – they will be sent electronically to Kernow Health.
- Contact details for Kernow Health on all communications

Parents have been emailed the letters from school with simple instructions, if you do have difficulty, or have not received this email, please speak to Jane in the school office. It would be appreciated if these could be completed for Kernow Health asap, even if your child will NOT be having the vaccine.

flu: 5 reasons to vaccinate your child

- ✓ **1. Protect your child.** The vaccine will help protect your child against flu and serious complications such as bronchitis and pneumonia
- ✓ **2. Protect you, your family and friends.** Vaccinating your child will help protect more vulnerable family and friends
- ✓ **3. No injection needed.** The nasal spray is painless and easy to have
- ✓ **4. It's better than having flu.** The nasal spray helps protect against flu, has been given to millions of children worldwide and has an excellent safety record
- ✓ **5. Avoid costs.** If your child gets flu, you may have to take time off work or arrange alternative childcare

What should I do?

Contact your GP if your child is aged two or three years old and you haven't heard from their GP by early November.

If your child is at primary school and is eligible, the school will send you a consent form. Please sign and return it.

If your child has a health condition that puts them at greater risk from flu, they are also eligible for the flu vaccine.

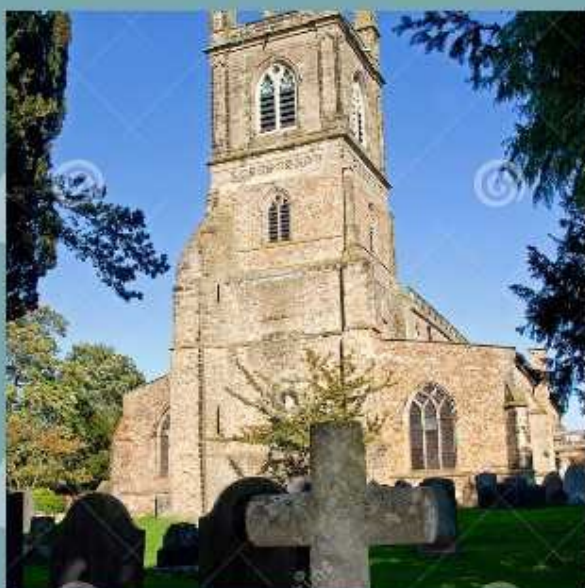
