Parent pay

Many thanks to those of you who have been using Parentpay this week. We hope that eventually this system will make bookings and payments for lunches, trips and wraparound care much easier for all of us.

It has been noted that there is slightly confusing wording with the booking of breakfast and afterschool clubs. For clarification:
