Hi Everyone,

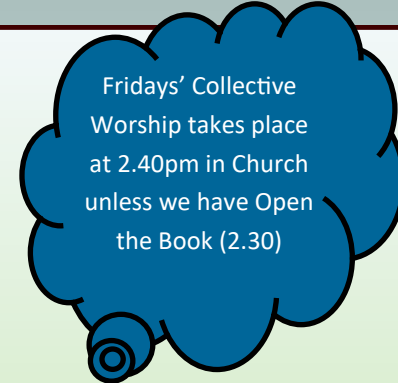
