Message from Mr Hobbs

A huge thank you to everyone who came to support during our Sports Day on Friday. It was a fantastic afternoon watching the children show determination and perseverance in their races. Thank you also to the PTFA for organising the refreshments and to all those mums and dads (and there were a lot of you) who jumped at the chance to take part in the parents races.

Friday was quite a busy day for many of the children. Blaise class were joined by Brendon Prince from the charity 'Above Water' who spoke to them about being safe around water and how to survive if they get into trouble. We then had a visit from Peter Faulkner who is a specialist rescue diver. Peter flew in on his helicopter (you may have heard it leave during Sports Day) to deliver 9 lifejackets to the school on behalf of the Lucas Dobson Water Safety Campaign. Lucas unfortunately lost his life when he fell into a strong current climbing aboard a boat. His family and Peter have set up the campaign to ensure that life jackets are available for those families who do not have access to any. The jackets will be stored at school but are free to use to any of our families.

On Tuesday we welcomed GB powerlifter Wesley McGuinness to the school to meet all of the children. Wesley led a school assembly on the field and spoke about the importance of looking after your body and eating healthily. He then led each of the classes through a circuit of exercises to show them how to strengthen their bodies. Thank you to everyone who raised sponsorship for this event. It was a huge success and raised over £400 pounds for the school.

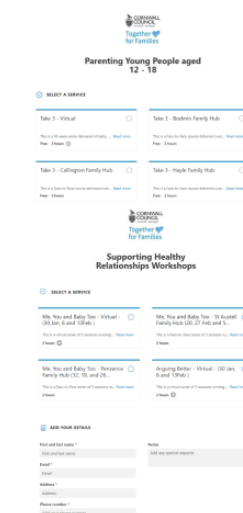
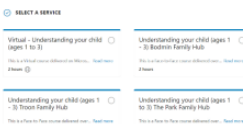
